Centrifugal Service Technician

Position Summary:

The position usually works eight (8) hour shifts however conditions in production can change rapidly and may require adjusting to schedule changes or respond to emergency call-ins and other needs in a plant that operates on a 24/7 basis. The job requires the individual to occasionally work in adverse weather conditions (cold, hot, humid, rain, snow, etc.). Travel to customer job sites for system evaluations, installations and troubleshooting is also required.

Key Job Responsibilities:

- Assist with disassembly and assembly of multiple brand centrifugal air compressors, in shop, or in field work setting.
- Troubleshooting issues with compressors, controllers, valves, etc.
- Clean up and inspect parts and components as needed.
- Maintain a clean and safe work area.
- Assist with other duties and needs, as required.

QUALIFICATIONS

- High school diploma or GED
- Proven field experience with centrifugal air compressors
- Must be mechanically inclined.
- Basic understanding of hand tools, mechanical equipment, electrical components, and pneumatic components.
- Ability to learn and apply new mechanical concepts.
- Willingness to travel with little notice and be gone for days, up to weeks at a time.
- Good work ethic, attitude, and get along well with others.
- Ability to work long hours, be away from home for extended amounts of time.
- Work in an industrial environment, and in extreme conditions.
- Work in shop, when not needed for field service.
- Good people/sales/communication skills
